

Middle School Wise Youth kick-starts the year and Wise Youth attendance an All-time high!





40 students have joined the Middle School Wise Youth (MSWY) group and 28 have joined High School Wise Youth (HSWY) for the 2015-16 school-year!

Wise Youth began in 2008 and through the diligent grant-writing efforts of WWGP, Wise Youth group will operate for the next three (3) years. We will focus on Sexual Assault Prevention thanks to a grant from the WI Coalition Against Sexual Assault and funding through the WI Department of Children and Families will support Teen Dating Violence prevention in our community. The HSWY members are a group of Native youth that lead in the delivery of healthy relationship programming at every MSWY group meeting.

MSWY group has engaged in following topics so far this year:

Norms - which is a list of ways that we agree to be with one another while in the space. It's important that the group is a safe place so that young people are able to be themselves, feel valued, and be heard.

Goal Setting – techniques and the message of "Beginning with the End in mind'. A goal equals a series of steps plus a series of dates.

Diary and Pyramid sheets - are from the Discovery Dating curriculum, written by Alice Skenandore who is the founder of WWGP. They include 36 elements that exist within a relationship and we use the sheets to get to know a person.

Personal Inventory - we used the Diary and Pyramid sheets mentioned above to look at ourselves. We write facts that we know about ourselves into the different categories with hope of identifying areas that are important to in our lives.

Wise Youth continues to seek funds from community so that both groups can meet weekly throughout the school-year. Meeting weekly and growing our financial support would allow group members to address other youth-identified topics like bystander intervention, practicing for job interviews, healthy relationships, changing how we treat the earth and helping to improve our community.
